

**COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS**  
**APRIL 1, 2024**

Mayor Greer called the special meeting to order at 5:30 p.m., April 1, 2024, at the City Hall Council Chambers, 10 W State Street, and led the pledge of allegiance. Roll call—Present: Kell, Ladehoff, Mitchell, Nichols, \*Schneider, Thompson (\*via Go-To-Meeting). There is a vacancy for 4<sup>th</sup> Ward Councilor.

**DISCUSSION**

Mayor Greer opened a public hearing at 5:31 pm for the Proposed Property Tax Levies for Fiscal Year 2025. The City Clerk did not receive any written comments. Public comment: Mark Eaton, 1007 S 10<sup>th</sup> Ave, noted there is a \$600,069 balance in the 78% local option sales tax fund for property tax relief which would be worth \$0.67 per \$1,000 on property taxes. He also questioned the changes in the employee benefits fund and transit authority fund. Diana Steiner, Finance Director, in order keep the rate the same as the current fiscal year at \$16.00 an additional \$1M was contributed from Local Option Sales Tax for property tax relief for a total of \$4,120,000. There was no council comments or questions. The public hearing was closed at 5:33 pm.

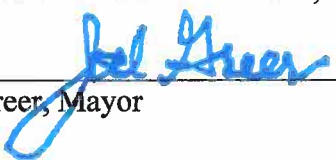
**ADJOURNMENT**
